IQAC Action Taken Report on Feedback Analysis


Academic Year 2022-23



Students have expressed satisfaction while pointing out the need for better Industry-Institute interaction. Teachers have highlighted the importance of enhancing the practical component of the teaching-learning process with research implementation while acknowledging the college's efforts in providing an enabling environment for learning. Alumni have expressed their satisfaction with the foundation provided by the college and their willingness to contribute to placements. Parents have expressed satisfaction with the college's infrastructure, teaching, and facilities.
