- To encourage the society for Female Literacy especially towards perusing Higher Educations.

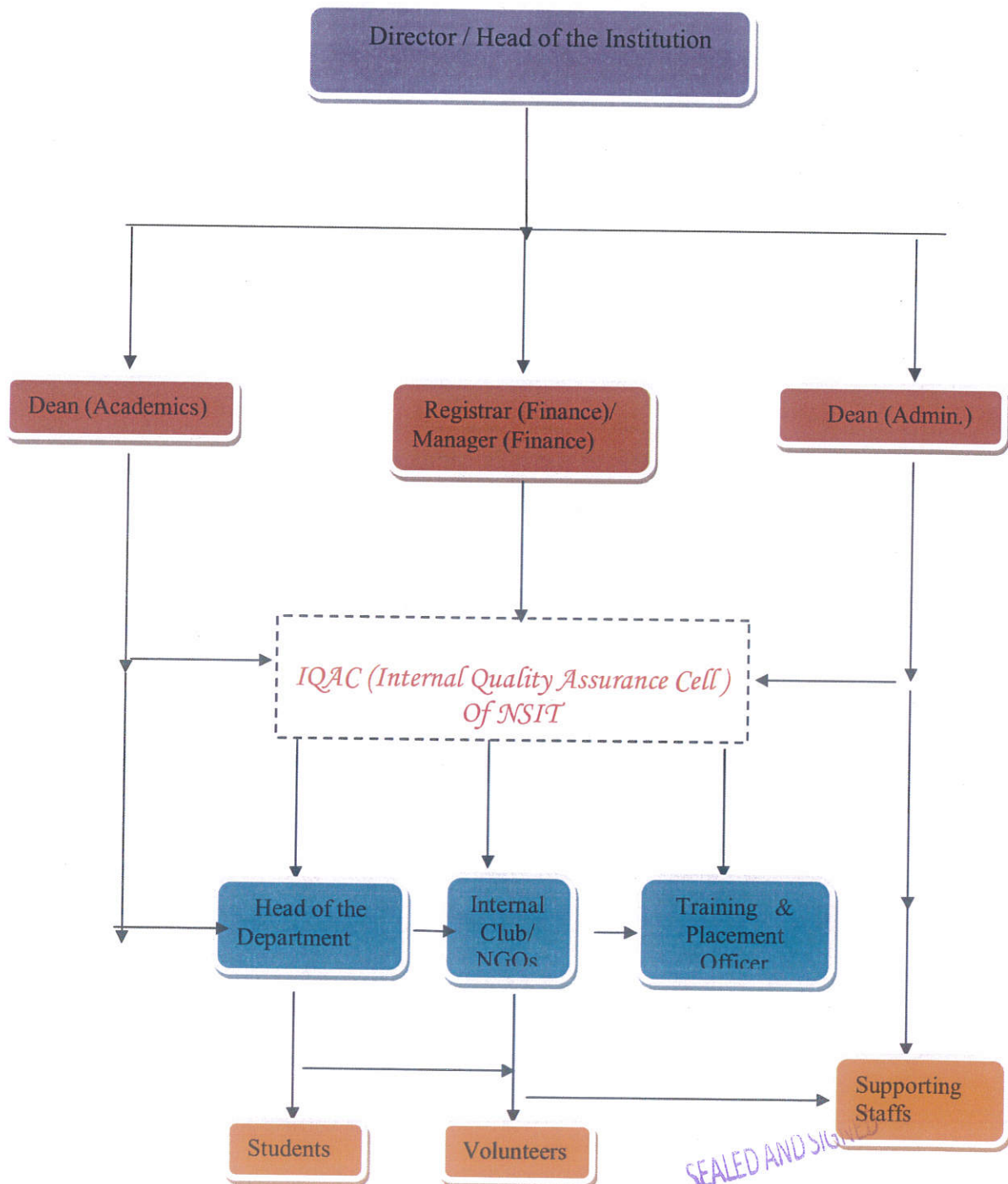
### **Activities based on multiple areas under the Outreach Program supported by NSIT are as follows:**



A Blood Donation Camp has been organized at Netaji Subhas Institute of Technology in collaboration with NSMCH Bihta.


